

3 OBJECTS AND FUNCTIONS

(a) Objects:

The principal object of the federation will be to promote the interests of all its Members, present in the states/UTs of Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Kerala, , to attain their social and economic betterment through self-help and mutual aid in accordance with the cooperative principles. The detailed objects shall be as follows:

1. **Comprehensive Seed Production:** Focus on the production of all three generations of seeds — Breeder, Foundation, and Certified — in farmers' fields or through cluster mode, ensuring high-quality outputs.
2. **Seed Testing and Certification:** Ensure rigorous testing and certification of seeds to maintain and enhance quality standards.
3. **Seed Distribution and Marketing:** Facilitate the production, storage, distribution, and marketing of High Yielding Variety (HYV) seeds to increase accessibility for farmers.

4. **Research and Development:** Promote research and development activities in the seed sector to develop new seed varieties and improve existing ones using the latest technologies.
5. **Adoption of Advanced Techniques:** Leverage modern technologies and scientific advancements to enhance the quality and quantity of seed production.
6. **Enhancing Farmer Participation:** Strengthen the role of farmers in seed cultivation, varietal trials, and quality improvement through active engagement and capacity-building initiatives.
7. **Policy and Scheme Integration:** Leverage various schemes and policies from different ministries of the Government of India, including support from the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare and its agencies such as ICAR and NSC, under the 'Whole of Government Approach.'
8. **Improving Seed and Varietal Replacement Rates:** Contribute to increasing the Seed Replacement Rate (SRR) and Varietal Replacement Rate (VRR) to enhance agricultural productivity.
9. **Strengthening Cooperatives:** Provide guidance and support to cooperatives at all levels to fortify the foundation of the cooperative movement and promote inclusive growth under the "Sahakar-se-Samridhi" model.
10. **Economic Benefits for Members:** Ensure that members benefit from better prices for quality seed production, increased crop yields through HYV seeds, and dividends from the surplus generated by the federation.
11. **Problem-Solving and Legal Support:** Address technical and legal challenges faced by members and provide documental assistance for complaints to the CRCS office.
12. **Training and Capacity Building:** Offer training on the Multi-State Cooperative Societies Act and Rules, as well as on best practices for seed production, certification, and marketing.
13. **Single Brand Name:** Establish a unified brand for certified seed distribution to ensure market visibility and trust.
14. **Strengthening Food Security:** Increase the availability of quality seeds to enhance agricultural productivity and contribute to national food security.
15. **Collaboration and Support:** Foster collective efforts among federation members to address shared challenges and achieve common goals.
16. **Incidental and Ancillary Activities:** Undertake any other incidental works necessary to achieve the federation's objectives effectively.

(B) FUNCTIONS:

In furtherance of the above objects, the society may undertake any or all the following activities:

- (a) ensure compliance of the co-operative principles;
- (b) make model bye-laws and policies for consideration of its member co-operative;
- (c) provide specialised training, education and data-base information;
- (d) undertake research, evaluation and assist in preparation of perspective development plans for its member co-operative;
- (e) promote harmonious relations amongst member co-operative;
- (f) help member co-operative to settle disputes among themselves;
- (g) undertake business services on behalf of its member co-operative, if specifically required by or under the resolution of the general body or the board, or bye-laws of a member of co-operative;
- (h) provide management development services to a member co-operative;
- (i) evolve code of conduct for observance by a member co-operative;
- (j) evolve viability norms for a member co-operative;
- (k) provide legal aid and advice to a member co-operative;
- (l) assist member co-operative in organising self-help;
- (m) develop market information system logo brand promotion, quality control and technology upgradation.
